






# Slack: Configuration Steps


To complete the steps below, you must first install the Slack adapter from the Marketplace in Enzo Manager. Make sure you see the Slack adapter on the left menu of Enzo Manager before proceeding.

<p>Go to <a href="https://api.slack.com/apps">https://api.slack.com/apps</a></p>	
<p>Click on the <b>Create an App</b> button</p>	
<p>Then Enter <b>Application Name</b>, select a workspace then click on the <b>Create App</b> button</p>	


Then scroll to the bottom of the page to find the **ClientId** and **ClientSecret**. You will need these values later.




On the same page go to the **OAuth & Permissions** Menu




Then click on Add Redirect Url




Enter Redirect  
Url: <http://localhost>



Click on the Add button  
then click on the  
**SaveUrls** button




Scroll down and select  
the **User Token  
Scopes** identified.  
Depending on the  
operations you are using  
in the Slack adapter, you  
may need additional  
scopes.




Click on **Install App** to generate the OAuth token.

You can add additional Scopes later; when doing so, select the **Reinstall App** button.

The OAuth token will be used shortly.



Click on **Allow**



Inside Enzo Manager, select the Slack adapter, and add a new Configuration. Enter the Access Token, ClientID and clientSecret as generated previously.

Check the "Make this the default setting" option and click OK.
